

Terms and Rules of the Camp on the Mann Property, 2023

(Revised 6/16/23)

These terms and rules for participating with us are only intended to aid in keeping the commandments out of love for Yeshua and your neighbors in the unity of the Spirit and for safeguarding a place for everyone to enjoy.

1. Obey the Torah of Moses as taught us by our Master Yeshua.
2. Respect camp elders, property owners, and private property.
3. THE LIABILITY WAIVER, holding harmless the property owner of all harm and injury, must be read and signed by the responsible member of each family and/or camp.
4. GRIEVANCES and offenses brought to the elder(s) must come by the process of Matthew 18 in the Spirit of reconciliation and by every word established by the mouth of two or three witnesses.
5. NO PARKING in front of the Mann's place of business or home.
6. NO CYCLING in the Oak Grove, by porta-potties and showers, nor by the property owners' business or house.
7. FIRE RESTRICTIONS: Know and comply with all applicable, local fire regulations.
8. FIREARMS: are allowed when in compliance with governing regulations; target practicing only as scheduled.
9. DRINKING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES must always be in moderation. Excess intoxication or drunkenness will not be tolerated.
10. CONTAINERS OF ALCOHOL must be concealed and always in the possession of consumers and never available to minors.
11. NO ILLEGAL DRUG taking or smoking illegal substances. Any person who possesses or willfully uses any behavior-altering drug or exhibits excessive or offensive intoxication will be required to leave the camp without re-admittance.
12. RECYCLE BINS are available to keep down on the amount of Trash. Rinse out all containers to reduce offensive odors.
13. DOGS must be on a leash at all times. Pick up pet waste in all areas and properly dispose in closed bags.
14. QUIET HOURS are from 10 PM to 7 AM, respecting sleeping neighbors and the business operations of Kelvin Mann.

15. WASH STATIONS: Trash cans are not to be used for personal garbage. Notify the sanitation crew of problems or if supplies run out.
16. SHOWERS: Remove shoes before entering. Wipe down the shower after use. Do not play or pee in a shower. Report any leak or broken fixture immediately!
17. ONEG: Pack and prepare extra food if you plan to attend a Group Oneg, in keeping with the commandment to not come empty-handed to a feast of YHWH. No impromptu Group Onegs allowed, they must be agreed upon and scheduled in advance.
18. CAMPFIRES: Parents or guardians must supervise their children at all times by campfires, by Group Tents, and during target practice. Before leaving, everyone must disassemble their personal fire pit. Any new ring stones must be removed and placed around the campfire ring inside the Oak Grove, the only permanent ring on the property.
19. LOST AND FOUND: ID your personal property! Please mark all personal property left in group places! Dishes, lawn chairs, toys, balls, etc. Place Lost and Found items in the box provided near the Group Kitchen facility.
20. UNMARRIED PERSONS of the opposite sex shall not offend others by staying together alone in the same private dwelling. Of course, immediate family is exempt.
21. SIGN UP SHEETS: Be prepared to Volunteer to Sign Up to serve and have your children serve as well for 'many hands make light work'.
22. No grumbling, complaining, gossip, or slander. Instead – REJOICE EVERY DAY OF THE FEAST! (Lev. 23:40)

Willful violations of these Camp rules may be grounds for immediate dismissal from the Camp without re-admittance.
